### **Membership fee**

Choose either the annual membership fee or lifetime membership fee.

Annual Membership Fee	All Age Group	2,000 yen per year
Lifetime Membership Fee	Under 40 years of age	Full membership: 50,000 JPY; Partial membership (Valid for 20 years): 30,000 JPY
	From 40 to 49 years of age	30,000 JPY
	From 50 to 59 years of age	20,000 JPY
	60 years of age or older	10,000 JPY

- \*The calculation of the lifetime membership fee in installments (valid for 20 years) shall begin from the fiscal year following graduation or course completion (i.e., the fiscal year the individual left the university) for current students. In all other cases, it shall begin from the fiscal year of admission to the association. The applicable age shall be determined based on the member's age at the end of the fiscal year of admission.
- \*Members may convert their annual membership to a lifetime membership. In such cases, if the total amount of annual membership fees already paid is less than the applicable lifetime membership fee at the time of admission, the member shall be required to pay the difference.

%Paid membership fees are not refundable.
